

Capa Excellence Award 2026

AWARD SELECTION & JURY RULES

1. Application Does Not Guarantee an Award
Submission of an application for the CAPA Award does not guarantee selection or conferment of an award.
2. Right of Selection
The Jury/Selection Committee constituted by the Council for Academic and Performance Appraisal (CAPA) shall have the sole and final authority to evaluate applications and select the award recipients.
3. Selection on Merit
Award selection shall be based on the applicant's eligibility, quality and relevance of work, achievements, contribution, impact, innovation and other criteria considered appropriate by the Jury/Selection Committee.
4. Jury's Decision Final
The decision of the Jury/Selection Committee regarding the selection, non-selection, number of awards, award category and conferment of awards shall be final and binding. No claim or right to an award shall arise merely from submission of an application.
5. Discretion of the Jury
The Jury/Selection Committee reserves the right to select, reject, defer or withhold an award in any category if, in its considered opinion, no application meets the required standard of merit.
6. No Guarantee of Award
Payment of any applicable registration/application fee, participation in the Symposium, recommendation, nomination or submission of documents shall not be construed as a guarantee or entitlement to receive an award.
7. Verification of Information
Applicants shall be responsible for the accuracy and authenticity of the information and documents submitted. CAPA/Jury may seek clarification or supporting documents wherever considered necessary.
8. Disqualification
An application may be rejected or an award may be withdrawn if any information is found to be false, misleading, fabricated or materially incomplete.
9. Conflict of Interest
Members of the Jury/Selection Committee shall make decisions

independently and in accordance with the applicable selection criteria. Where considered necessary, a member may abstain from evaluating an application involving a direct conflict of interest.

10. Amendment / Modification

CAPA reserves the right to modify the award categories, eligibility criteria, evaluation process or programme-related arrangements, where necessary, in the interest of the programme.

11. No Correspondence on Jury Decision

The Jury/Selection Committee shall not ordinarily be required to provide individual explanations or reasons for non-selection. Its decision shall remain final.

IMPORTANT

Applying for an award means submitting your candidature for consideration; it does not mean that an award is assured. The final decision rests solely with the duly constituted Jury/Selection Committee of CAPA.
